

German Intensive

The perfect choice for those who want to make rapid progress: Our Intensive Course combines daily classes with guided self-study — an ideal preparation for university, professional life, or integration in Germany. You will benefit from regular lessons (on-site or online) and a lively cultural program that helps you use the language in real-life situations.

German Part-Time

Designed for people who want to balance language learning with work or other commitments: The Part-Time Course takes place in the evenings and once a month on Saturdays. In small groups, you build your skills step by step, with time for consolidation and self-study. Interactive methods such as role plays and authentic materials make learning both effective and engaging.

German Standard

Ideal for learners with solid foundations who want to use German confidently in everyday life, formal settings, or their career. The Standard Course focuses on handling complex texts and expressing yourself precisely in spoken and written communication. You will also strengthen your intercultural skills, helping you navigate diverse communication situations with confidence.


What format is employed for course instruction?

- **Face-to-Face:** This format takes place in the classroom with the option to join every session live online thanks to our hybrid setup. Integration & Vocational Language Courses

"Integrationskurs" (A1 - B1)

The general integration course consists of a total of 700 TU, each lasting 45 minutes. In the language course (600 TU), you will learn German for everyday life and work up to level B1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. In the orientation course (100 TU), you will learn basic knowledge about society, culture, politics, values, and rules in Germany.

"Berufssprachkurs" (B2 - C2)

German for work and everyday life! The vocational language course (in accordance with § 45 AufenthG) is aimed at migrants who are looking for work or training and want to prepare themselves linguistically for (professional) life in Germany.

for free*

Requirements for Participation:

- Certificate of eligibility from BAMF, jobcenter or similar
- Fluid mastery of Latin script

If you are authorized or obliged to take part in an integration course, the BAMF will pay half of the course fees (€ 2.29 per teaching unit). The other half of the fees must be paid by the participant. If you are in financial need, you can apply for a cost exemption, in which case the BAMF will pay the full course fees. Some authorizations or obligations automatically exempt from the costs.

*Depending on your eligibility, participation is free of charge or requires a partial contribution towards costs.





Integration & Vocational Language Courses

Our well-trained instructors are certified by the BAMF (Bundesamt für Migration und Flüchtlinge) and have native-speaker proficiency. The language of instruction in our courses is German. Our classrooms are very well equipped with technology, and you have free access to Wi-Fi in all areas. The number of participants is a minimum of 12. The textbook and workbook must be purchased separately for each module. A placement test will determine your starting level so that you can begin with the appropriate module.
